MINUTES OF PUBLIC HEARING

April 7, 2026

PUBLIC HEARING

On April 7, 2026, Rock-Moore Public Water Authority held a Public Hearing on the matter of issuance of two water revenue bond resolutions. All Directors were in attendance along with attorney Edward Boyce and Rural Development's Billy Holland and Keith Huskey.

President Carter called the meeting to order. He, then, turned the meeting over to attorney Edward Boyce.

Mr. Boyce opened the public hearing for issuance of two water revenue bond resolutions. He asked if any persons would like to step forward to be heard with respect to the resolutions. After no comments from the public, the public hearing was closed by President Carter.

Next, there was a special bond hearing on the two water revenue bond resolutions: 2026 A in the amount of \$1,514,000.00 and 2026 B in the amount of \$1,018,000.00. Mr. Boyce needed a vote and approval on each resolution from the Directors. Director Pearce made a motion to approve Resolution A, and Director Scribner made a second. The motion carried. Resolution 2026 B received a motion from Director Pearce. Vice-President Hopper seconded, and the motion carried. Mr. Boyce discussed the 30-day waiting period required by state law before proceeding with the loan closing, and Mr. Huskey added this was to assure compliance with the Freedom of Information Act. A pre-construction hearing will be scheduled on or around May 11, 2026. Mason Allen, Crist Engineers, confirmed the contract documents had been sent to the contractor and bonding companies for execution, which need to be reviewed by the agency before the pre-construction hearing can take place.

The meeting was adjourned with a motion by Vice-President Hopper and seconded by Director Smith. The motion carried.
